# **Imperium International College Scholarships and Bursaries**

Since its establishment in 2010, Imperium International College has awarded many scholarships to encourage Malaysians and International students who demonstrate academic excellence and leadership qualities to pursue their tertiary education at the College. Many of these recipients have completed their programmes and have embarked on successful careers.

Imperium International College welcomes high achieving new and continuing students to apply for scholarships and study awards.

## **Application Procedure for Full Scholarships, Partial Scholarships and Study Awards**

If you meet the minimum criteria, you are required to do the following:

1. Complete the Imperium International College Scholarship Application Form and attach certified copies of your academic transcript.
2. To apply, new students are required to submit an Imperium International College Application Form for the chosen programme and proceed to pay the Student Application Fee before submitting the scholarship application form.
3. New students **MUST** submit the respective forms and attachments to the Scholarship Officer in the Registry before the specified deadline. Late applications will not be considered for selection.
4. The decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final, and appeals will not be entertained.

## Important Notes

1. As scholarship awards are limited and competitive, only candidates who meet the minimum criteria specified are eligible to apply.
2. Meeting the minimum criteria does not automatically guarantee the applicant a scholarship.
3. All scholarship applicants will be evaluated and shortlisted by the Scholarship Committee of Imperium International College. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to revise the criteria from time to time without prior notice. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
4. Students are only entitled to one scholarship at any one time.
5. Scholarships also cover prizes, study awards, bursaries and fee waivers.
6. Applicants may be awarded a sum that is less than what is stipulated in the brochure, depending on the availability of the Scholarship Fund.
7. All scholarships are awarded on a First Come, First Served Basis.
8. Scholarships may differ from intake to intake. Students are advised to submit their application before the stipulated deadline.
9. Scholarship applicants should check with the Scholarship Officer on the deadline for submission.

# Description of Eligibility Criteria

## Sports Excellence

The above financial aid is awarded to registered students who have excelled in sports and have represented the state or country in competitions.

### Value

- 50% waiver in tuition fee for State athletes.
- 60%\* waiver in tuition fee for National athletes.

\* Applications may be considered on a case-by-case basis and a higher quantum may be awarded.

### Eligibility

- Full-time Malaysian students in Imperium International College who are state or national sports personalities two years before joining the College.
- Sport(s) excelled in should be affiliated with the Olympic Council Malaysia or National Sports Council.
- Verification of student status as sports personalities is done by the National or State Sports Association.
- Recipients must maintain the following minimum GPA for the duration of the scholarship:
  - i. GPA 2.75 out of a maximum of 4.00, if actively involved in sports. This includes but not limited to participating in national and/or state level competitions, attending trainings, etc.
  - ii. GPA 3.50 out of a maximum of 4.00, if not actively involved in sports.

# Description of Eligibility Criteria

## BUDIMAS Scholarship

The Budimas Charitable Foundation is offering Scholarship for Malaysian students to pursue higher education for full time programmes at IIC. This scholarship covers tuition fees, monthly allowance and accommodation.

### Eligibility

- Open to Malaysian citizens aged between 18 and 24 who wish to pursue tertiary education.
- Total gross monthly household income of RM4,000 and below.
- Applicants should possess good academic qualifications and should be active in school.
- Minimum academic requirement:
  - i. Foundation and Diploma – minimum 5 A's in SPM and credit in other subjects
  - ii. Degree - CGPA 3.5 and above in STPM
    - 3 A's in A Level and credit in other subjects
    - CGPA 3.5 and above in Diploma/Foundation
- Only official exam result will be accepted for scholarship consideration.
- Recipients cannot change programme halfway in their studies.
- Accommodation and monthly allowance will be included with the scholarship.
- Applicants must not be bonded or receiving any form of financial aid or award from other educational institutions or organisations.
- Applicants must have good health and not suffering from critical illnesses.
- Recipients must maintain the following conditions for the duration of the scholarship:
  - i. A minimum of 80% class attendance
  - ii. A minimum of GPA 2.20 out of a maximum 4.00 in every exam sessions

# Terms and Conditions

## A. General

1. Scholarships/financial aid is available to Malaysian and International Students.
2. The scholarships and financial aid offered is strictly for full-time registered students at Imperium International College. Applicants must make full payment of application and administration fees before they are eligible to apply for scholarships. Otherwise, the scholarship application is considered null and void. For new students, the administration fee will be refunded if the application is not successful.
3. Scholarships and financial aid awarded is provided in the form of tuition fee waiver.
4. Scholarships are normally for the duration of the programme
5. The scholarships/financial aid does not include fees for referral subjects, repeated subjects, examination fees, franchise fees and any English language course that is not part of your main programme, Mata Pelajaran Pengajian Umum (MPU) subjects, and distance education fees, where applicable.
6. It is to be noted that scholarships/financial aid awarded is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash.
7. Students receiving scholarships/financial aid from other bodies or institutions are not eligible to apply for the awards of Imperium International College.
8. Students will be entitled to only one scholarship or bursary (whichever is higher) and students are not allowed to combine awards.
9. The award of scholarships/financial aid requires recipients to meet entry requirements of the programmes.
10. Applicants may accept only one scholarship/financial aid at any one time.
11. The final decision to grant a scholarship/financial aid is at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee of Imperium International College. Only shortlisted applicants will be notified.

# Terms and Conditions

## A. General

12. Imperium International College reserves the right to revoke any scholarship in case of failure in examinations, unauthorized dropping of courses, and withdrawal from a programme before completion and / or non-compliance with IIC Rules and Regulations or with other terms and conditions of the scholarship. Recipients may be required to repay the scholarship amount used upon revocation of the scholarship.
13. Recipients of scholarships who are subsequently found in breach of Imperium International College rules and regulations, academic or otherwise, will have their scholarships revoked and will be required to repay Imperium International College the said sum of money.
14. Recipients of scholarships are required to contribute 3-5 hours per week of their time to assist the Head of Department or his designated staff in administration, peer counselling, extracurricular activities, marketing and promotional activities.
15. The Terms and Conditions for the Imperium International College scholarships and financial aid are correct at the time of printing and may be modified or amended from time to time as deemed reasonable and appropriate by Imperium International College.
16. Imperium International College reserves the right to involve the scholarship/financial aid recipients in interviews, advertisements or other publicity-related activities for the purpose of promoting the institution.
17. The qualifications required for the scholarship may vary from year to year. Applicants should check with the Scholarship Officer on the requirements before applying.
18. Late and incomplete application forms will not be considered for selection.

# Terms and Conditions

## B. Diploma

- The scholarship /financial aid commences in Semester 1. Applicants must make full payment of fees prior to receiving the award.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 out of 4.00 (for scholarship quantum less than 50%) or 3.50 out of 4.00 (for scholarship quantum above 50%) to continue receiving the scholarship for the duration of the scholarship/financial aid.

## C. Degree

- The scholarship / financial aid will be implemented from the Semester 1 of the programme. Applicants must make full payment of fees prior to receiving the award.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 out of 4.00 (for scholarship quantum less than 50%) or 3.50 out of 4.00 (for scholarship quantum above 50%) to continue receiving the scholarship for the duration of the scholarship/financial aid.
- Decision on the continuation of the scholarship is at the sole discretion of the Head of Centre of the respective programme and the Scholarship Committee.

## D. Association of Chartered Accountants (ACCA)
